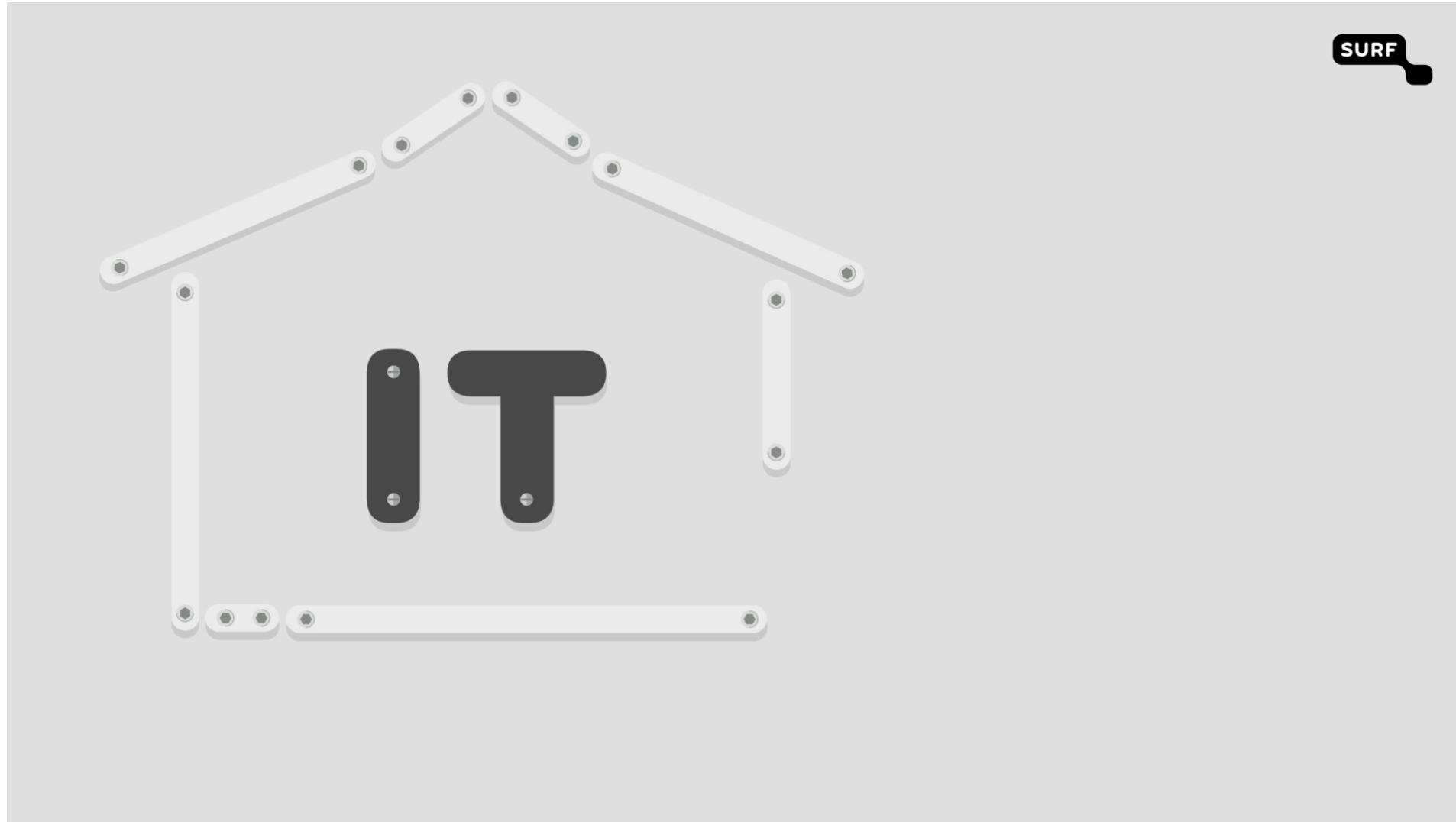

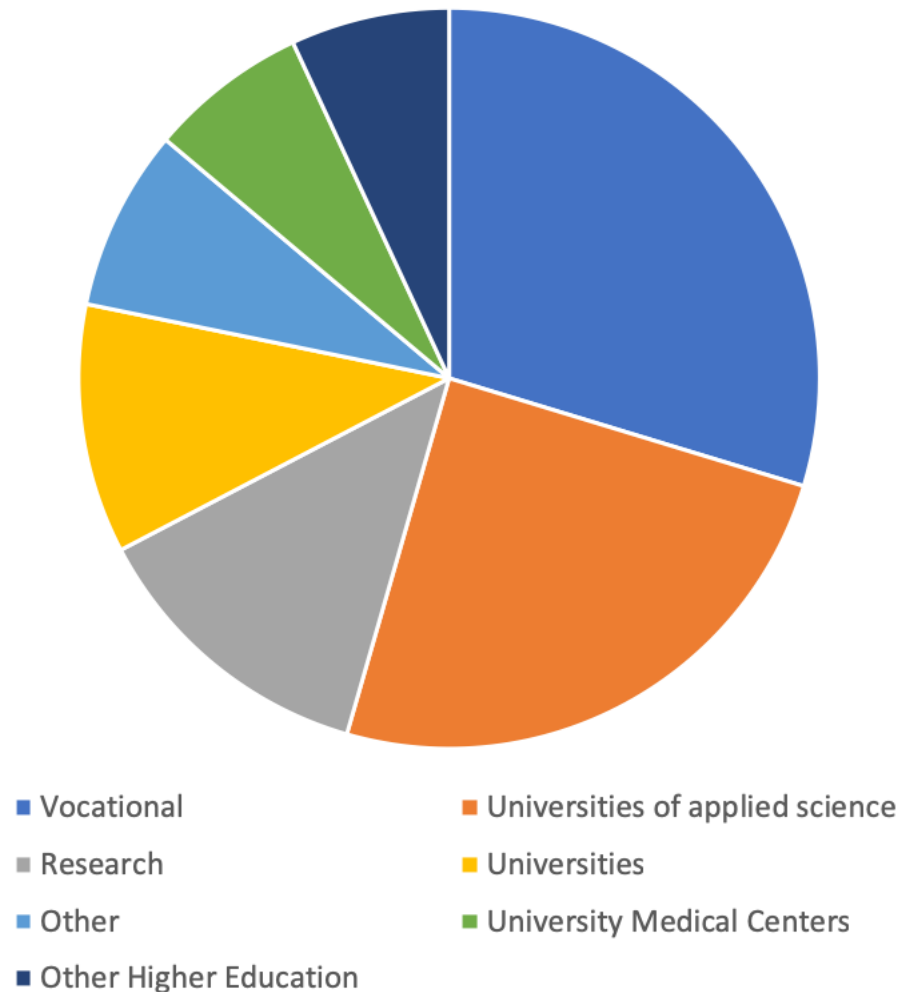

- 101 institutions use SURFcumulus
- Annual gross turnover grew from 2 Mio in 2017 to 5.5 Mio Euro in 2018

SURFcumulus Roadmap 2019

- Support Research and University Medical Center adoption of cloud services
- Focus on training offers: increases knowledge and lowers risks
- Offer Cloud Management Portal functionality to support legacy on-premises environments
- Gross turnover will grow to 10 million Euro over 2019
- SURFcumulus has become the default delivery model for public cloud services for R&E sector in the Netherlands
